#### **Latter-day Saints Online**



The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints (often known as the Mormons) was organised in 1830. Many think of the Church as an American organisation but few appreciate that it has been present in the British Isles since 1837. Between then and the turn of the century around 100,000 converts joined the Church in Britain before emigrating. For over 50 years, from 1840 onwards, the Church was dominated by British converts. Even today a significant portion of the American members are descended from those British converts. Many important events took place here and many of the Church's well known leaders gained experience while labouring on our shores.

With around 180,000 members currently in the British Isles, this web site sets out to provide an understanding of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, its British history and the activities of the Church here now. It provides a useful resource both to members of the Church and to those interested in finding out more.


